## Introduction

Mariko Konishi has been a lecturer for Ethics and Clinical Philosophy at Osaka University (Osaka, Japan) since 2018. She completed her Ph.D (2014) at Ritsumeikan University (Kyoto, Japan). She was a Doctoral and Postdoctoral Research Fellow of the Japan Society for the Promotion of Science (2012-2018). Her main present work focuses on “Pathology of Relationship” and “Addiction and Modern Family” viewing from perspective of the Ethics of Care, and employs a trans-disciplinary approach. She published her dissertation in Japanese titled *The Ethics of Codependence* (Koyoshobo, 2017).
