## **Introduction**

Wei-Lun Lee is Professor at the Department of Counseling and Clinical Psychology, National Dong Hwa University, Taiwan. He is also a licensed clinical psychologist in Taiwan. He received his doctoral degree (1999) in clinical psychology from Duquesne University. His areas of specialization include phenomenological psychology, phenomenological methodology, psychotherapy as ethical care, and the development of indigenous clinical psychology. Dr. Lee is currently interested in building up a psychological healing model called “existential hypnotherapy” and articulating a training framework called “praxical psychology” with Hannah Arendt’s inspiration.
