My academic work has been awarded with several prizes and fellowships, and I have developed and taught eight university-level courses related to various aspects of Chinese literature, history, and society. In addition to writing news articles and reportage for Danish newspapers, I have also published short stories and poetry in various journals. In my sparetime I have been involved as a creative reading and writing instructor in various community projects aimed at the elderly, at migrant children, and at people struggling with various psychological disabilities. Among other academic projects, I have co-edited and translated an edited volume about gender issues in the PRC (Palgrave 2016), and most recently I have written an article about Sinophone science fiction.
